

Another Round of Rain; Potential Localized Flooding Tonight into Early Saturday



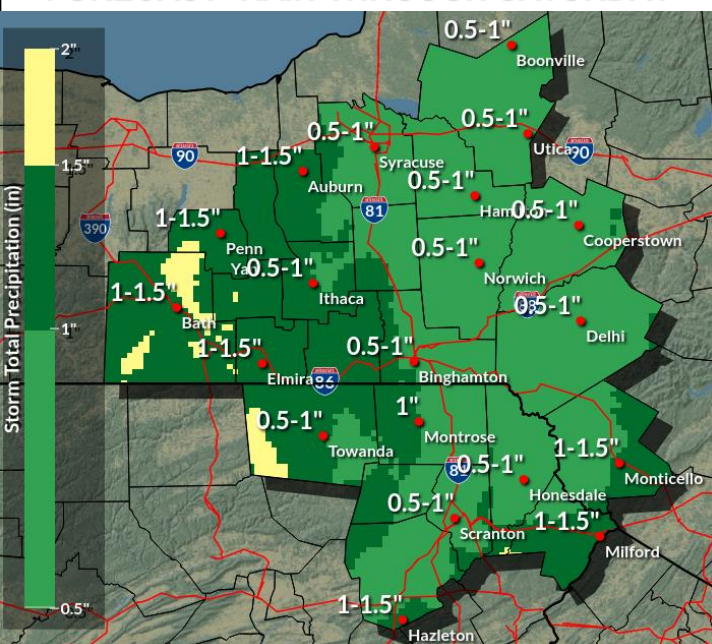

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Dry through most of today, but still with elevated river/lake levels.
- Large low pressure system is forecast to bring rain into the area late this afternoon and **especially tonight-early Saturday** when it may be locally heavy.
- Given the very wet conditions from earlier this week, this new rain will be prone to running off into creeks/streams tonight and eventually rivers and lakes on Saturday. **Localized flooding will be possible.**

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Heaviest rain tonight, but localized flooding possible into Sat. as well.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Ponding of water on roads and poor-drainage areas. ▪ Road flooding especially where leaves clog drains. ▪ Localized flooding of creeks/streams possible tonight-early Saturday. ▪ Rivers rising on Saturday; a few points could approach minor flood stage.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None at this time. Monitor the forecast for updates.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Rain will be less than what occurred with the system earlier this week, yet it will also not take as much to cause flooding given the very wet conditions. ▪ Main forecast challenge is figuring out whether and where the combination from both events will be enough for additional flooding.
